## Narrowing down the People through whom Jesus came (Messianic Line)

**Adam** (Genesis 3:15) → Messiah would be <u>a male</u>

Shem (Genesis 9:26) → Messiah would come from the <u>race of Shem</u>

**Abraham** (Genesis 22:18) → Messiah would come from the <u>nation of Abraham</u>

**Isaac** (Hebrews 11:17-19) → Messiah would come from the <u>line of Isaac</u>

**Jacob** (Matthew 1:2) → Messiah would come from the <u>seed of Jacob</u>

**Judah** (Genesis 49:10) → Messiah would come from the <u>tribe of Judah</u>

**Jesse** (Isaiah 11:1) → Messiah would come from the <u>family of Jesse</u>

**David** (Matthew 1:1) → Messiah would come from the <u>house of David</u>

Mary (Isaiah 7:14) → Messiah would be born of a virgin

Why did God bring Messiah in this way? 1) He wanted Jesus to be the obvious Messiah by providing many prophecies matching Jesus to each one (providing overwhelming proof Jesus was Messiah), 2) throughout the time God brought about Messiah, He had to deal with men's sins and Satan's nefarious deeds that delayed – but did not fail – to bring Messiah into the world, 3) so even today men could know Jesus is Messiah/Christ/Savior by right of His line, by the overwhelming evidence of prophecy, and Jesus' own testimony of His resurrection that He is Lord!
