

The Lord's Supper – What does the Bible say?

<u>View</u>	<u>Purpose</u>	<u>Belief and Practice</u>
Catholic	Transubstantiation	Literal transformation into the body and blood of Christ Daily partaking (mass held daily all but 2 days of the year – Good Friday and Holy Saturday)
BIBLE	Communion	Communion with the saving benefits of the body & blood of Christ (1 Corinthians 10:16-18; John 6:51-58; Luke 22:19-20; 1 Corinthians 11:24-28; Matthew 26:26-28; Acts 2:42; Acts 20:7; Mark 14:22-25) Weekly partaking as commanded by Jesus, practiced by the early church, and taught by the Apostle Paul.
Denominational	Memorial	Only a Symbol of the sacrifice of Jesus Occasional partaking
