Summary (see 1 Corinthians 14:22-25 for New Testament teaching on the below):

- 9 Miracle + Preaching Opportunity Instance = 9 Instances of Conversion (preaching led to faith each time)
- 4 Preaching Opportunity w/ No Miracle = 4 Instances of Conversion (faith comes by hearing Rom. 10:17)
- 1 Miracle w/ No Preaching Opportunity = 0 Instances of Conversion (without preaching, no saving faith)

We can be certain that preaching provides opportunity for conversion, not miracles!

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
